- Natural Gas is OUT, Electrification is IN
- Motto's of today's climate change movement:
 - "Keep it in the ground"
 - "Electrify Everything"
- Green New Deal Preventing catastrophic global climate change requires a "World War II" style mobilization of the national economy and workforce to aggressively eliminate carbon within decades.
- <u>Overall goal</u>: 50% reduction by 2030, 80%+ by 2050



Public Perception of Climate Change

- Recent Yale University study:
 - 70% of Americans believe in global warming
 - 57% say its "caused mostly by human activities"
 - Polls conducted in "blue" states are even higher
- University of Chicago/AP poll:
 - 44% of Americans support a carbon tax or fee
 - While most would pay \$1 per month to fight global warming,
 ...23% would pay \$40 per month
 ...16% would pay \$100 or more per month




- Activists emboldened by changing public opinions
- Democrats are seizing new majorities and supermajorities in the Northeast to advance the agenda
- Policies to "electrify everything" being advanced
 - Carbon taxes, bans on fossil fuel infrastructure
 - · Heating sector seen as "low hanging fruit"
 - Incentives to convert to heat pumps
 - Regional initiatives: RGGI expansion (TCI), HydroQuebec, LCFS
 - Clean electricity standards: Renewable/Alternative Portfolio Standards (APS/RPS)



- "Electrify everything" movement <u>targeting all fossil</u>
 <u>fuels</u> including propane and natural gas.
- Image harmed by Merrimack Valley explosion Rhode Island Service Interruption, other recent events
- Natural gas industry is alarmed
 - Pushing "biogas" (using the Bioheat[®] playbook)
 - Creating problems (moratoria on expansion) in search of solutions (pressuring states to support natural gas pipelines)
 - President Trumps recent Executive Orders
